By using three strands of cotton yarn it makes this **Tricolor Crochet Market Bag Pattern** sturdy, colorful, and quick to work up! This bag uses almost exactly three 100g cotton skeins of yarn. This would be a great stash buster! Pick three colors that coordinate and you can make this quick and easy bag! I especially love how strong it is because of the three strands of yarn.

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Materials

I Love this Cotton in Amethyst, Royalty, Dark Denim

N/P 10.0 mm hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

Level

easy to intermediate (must be very familiar with basic crochet stitches and techniques)

Pattern Notes & Stitches to Know

sl st - slip stitch

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

magic ring

crochet into 3rd loop of hdc

Ch at beginning of rounds do not count as stitch, *unless otherwise noted*

Approximate Finished Size

Body of the bag: 12" x 13"

Straps: 9"

Pattern

With all three strands, make a magic ring (or ch 3 and join to first ch to make a loop)

Round 1: ch 1, sc 8 into ring, join to first sc with sl st, pull ring closed tight (8 sc)

Round 2: ch 1, 2 sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (16 sc)

Round 3: ch 1, *sc in 1 stitch, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (24 sc)

Round 4: ch 1, *sc in 2 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (32 sc)

Round 5: ch 1, *sc in 3 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (40 sc)

Round 6: ch 1, *sc in 4 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (48 sc)

Round 7: ch 1, *sc in 5 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (56 sc)

Circle should be approximately 8 inches in diameter

Round 8: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (56 sc)

Round 9: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (56 sc)

Round 10: ch 1, hdc in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (56 hdc)

Round 11: ch 1, hdc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (56 hdc)

Round 12: ch 1, hdc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (56 hdc)

Round 13: ch 1, sc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (56 sc)

Round 14: ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), *skip 1 stitch, dc in next, ch 1* repeat from * to * around, join to top of first ch 3 (28 dc)

Round 15: ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * around, join to top of first ch 3 with sl st (28 dc)

Round 16: ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * around, join to top of first ch 3 with sl st (28 dc)

Round 17: ch 1, hdc in each stitch and ch space around, join to first hdc with sl st (56 hdc)

Round 18: ch 1, hdc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (56 hdc)

Round 19: ch 1, hdc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (56 hdc)

Round 20: ch 1, sc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (56 sc)

The straps are made in this last round

Round 21: ch 1, sc in 7 stitches, ch 35, skip 14 stitches, sc in next 14 stitches, ch 35, skip 14 stitches, sc in last 7 stitches, join to first sc with sl st (28 sc)

Fasten off, weave in the ends.

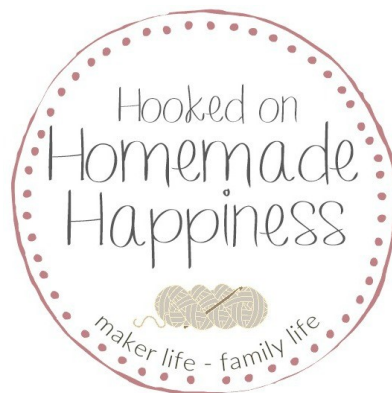
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
