Materials

Worsted weight yarn

J/6.0 mm hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

Level

Easy -you must be very familiar with basic crochet stitches

Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

Turning ch DOES NOT COUNT as a stitch in this part

PART 2 - WAVE STITCH

Join yarn to end of row 6

Row 7: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch across (169)

Row 8: ch 1, turn, hdc in first 2 stitches, dc in next 2 stitches, tr in next 3 stitches, dc in next 2 stitches, hdc in next 2 stitches, *sc in next 3 stitches, hdc in next 2 stitches, dc in next 2 stitches, tr in next 3 stitches, dc in next 2 stitches, hdc in next 2 stitches* repeat from * to * across ending with 1 hdc (169)

Row 9: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch across (169)

Row 10: ch 2, turn, dc in first 2 stitches, hdc in next 2 stitches, *sc in next 3 stitches, hdc in next 2 stitches, dc in next 2 stitches, tr in next 3 stitches, dc in next 2 stitches, hdc in next 2 stitches*, repeat from * to * across ending with 1 dc

Row 11: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch across (169)

Row 12: repeat row 8

Row 13: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch across (169)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends or add fringe.
