Materials

Worsted weight acrylic or cotton yarn (I used Loops & Threads Impeccable)

H/5.0 mm

yarn needle

scissors

Level

Easy -you must be very familiar with basic crochet stitches

Pattern notes & stitches to know

magic loop

sl st - slip stitch

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

hdc - half double crochet

sc - single crochet

puff stitch - *yarn over, insert hook into stitch, pull up a loop the height of a dc*
repeat 2 more times, yarn over and pull through all 7 loops on hook

3rd loop - insert hook into the 3rd loop of the hdc and work the stitch

- Written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- ch 1 does not count as hdc
- This beanie is worked from the top down starting with a magic loop. There is a combination of joined rounds and turned rounds.

Approx Finished Size (teen/small adult):

Length: 8" Circumference: 20"

SNOWDROP BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN

Make a magic loop

Round 1: ch 2, 10 dc into loop, pull closed tight, join to first dc with sl st (10 dc)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (20 dc)

Round 3: ch 2, *dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (30 dc)

Round 4: ch 2, *dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (40 dc)

Round 5: ch 2, *dc in 3 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (50 dc)

Round 6: ch 2, *dc in 4 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Crown diameter should be approx. 7". Add or take out increase rounds as needed.

Round 7: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 8: ch 1, hdc in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (60 hdc)

The rest of the beanie is worked in turned rounds.

Round 9: ch 1, turn, working in the 3rd loop only in every stitch around *puff stitch in 1 stitch, sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first stitch with sl st (60)

Round 10: ch 1, turn, hdc in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (60 hdc)

Round 11: ch 1, turn, working in the 3rd loop only in every stitch around *sc in 1 stitch, puff stitch in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first stitch with sl st (60)

Round 12: ch 1, turn, hdc in each stitch around, join to first hdc with sl st (60 hdc)

Repeat rounds 9 - 12 to **Round 18** (60 hdc)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.


