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The **Woven Beanie Crochet Pattern** uses the basket weave stitch to create this pretty woven look. I love all the different textures of this beanie with the ribbed brim, the basket weave, and the fun pom pom.

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<u>Materials</u>

Approx. 290 yds worsted weight yarn (I used Sugarbush Bold in Silver Islet)

H/5.0 mm hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

(optional) pom pom

<u>Level</u>

Intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

SI st - slip stich

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Sc blo - single crochet back loop only

Dc - double crochet

Fpdc - front post double crochet

Bpdc - back post double crochet

Fpdc2tog - front post double crochet 2 together (front post double crochet decrease)

Bpdc2tog - back post double crochet 2 together (back post double crochet decrease)

Written in US terms

Beginning ch does not count as stitch

Approximate Finished Size (adult):

Width: 9.5"

Length: 9" (not including pom pom)

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WOVEN BEANIE

hat is worked from the bottom up starting with the ribbed brim
Ch 10

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from the hook and across (9)

Row 2: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, sc blo in next 7, sc in last (9)

Repeat row 2 to **Row 78** (to adjust circumference, add or take out ribbing. The number of rows must be a multiple of 6)

Bring both ends of the ribbing together to create a circle. Sc both short ends together. Now you will work around the long edge of the ribbing to start the body of the beanie.

Round 1: ch 1, sc evenly around working 1 sc in the end of each row, join to first sc with sl st (78)

Round 2: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (78)

Round 3: ch 2, *fpdc in 3 stitches, bpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st (78)

Round 4: repeat round 3

Round 5: repeat round 3

Round 6: ch 2, *bpdc in 3 stitches, fpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * around, join to first bpdc with sl st (78)

Round 7: repeat round 6

Round 8: repeat round 6

Repeat rounds 3 - 8 to Round 22

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Decreasing starts in next round

Round 23: ch 2, *fpdc, fpdc2tog, bpdc, bpdc2tog* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st (52)

Round 24: ch 2, *fpdc2tog, bpdc2tog* repeat from * to * around, join to first stitch with sl st (26)

Fasten off, leave a long end for sewing.

With yarn needle, weave the long end in a out of the top loops of the last round. Pull end tight to cinch the top closed. Sew the top closed. Weave in the ends.

Add a pom pom!
