The **Basketweave Bucket Hat Crochet Pattern** starts as a basic double crochet beanie with a cute textured brim - perfect for summer! I used acrylic yarn for this pattern (and it worked perfectly), but if I were to make it again I would choose a cotton worsted. It just works much better for summer!

## **Materials**

100g worsted weight yarn (I used I Love this Yarn)

G/4,0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

easy+

## Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic circle (or ch 3 and sl st to first ch to make a circle)

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

fpdc - front post double crochet

bpdc - back post double crochet

sc - single crochet

- Written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as a stitch
- ch 1 does not count as a stitch
- This beanie is made from the top down with joined rounds.
- To change the pattern size, go up or down a hook size. You can also add or take out an increase round.

Approx Finished size (adult) - Length: 9" Circumference: 21"

### BASKETWEAVE BUCKET HAT CROCHET PATTERN

Make a magic circle

**Round 1**: ch 2, 12 dc in circle, pull circle closed tight, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

**Round 2**: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (24 dc)

**Round 3**: ch 2, \*dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (36 dc)

**Round 4**: ch 2, \*dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)

**Round 5**: ch 2, \*dc in 3 stitches, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

**Round 6**: ch 2, \*dc in 4 stitches, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (72 dc)

**Round 7**: ch 2, \*dc in 5 stitches, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (84 dc)

Crown diameter is approx 7.25"

Round 8 - 13: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (84 dc)

**Round 14**: ch 2, \*fpdc, bpdc\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first fpdc with sl st (84)

**Round 15**: ch 2, \*bpdc, fpdc\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first bpdc with sl st (84)

Repeat rounds 14 & 15 to Round 17

**Round 18**: ch 1, \*sc in 5 stitches, 2 sc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first sc with sl st (98 sc)

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**Round 19**: ch 1, \*sc in 6 stitches, 2 sc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first sc with sl st (112 sc)

**Round 20**: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (112 sc)

**Round 21**: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (112 sc)

**Round 22**: ch 1, \*sc in 7 stitches, 2 sc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first sc with sl st (126 sc)

**Round 23**: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (126 sc)

**Round 24**: ch 1, \*sc in 8 stitches, 2 sc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first sc with sl st (140 sc)

**Round 25**: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (140 sc)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
