WIDE BRIM BABY BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



The Wide Brim Baby Hat Crochet Pattern is a super quick & easy pattern. The stretchy ribbing will be nice and cozy around a little one's ears!

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Materials

60g worsted weight yarn (I used Paintbox Simply Aran)

H/5.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

Level

easy

Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic circle

sl st - slip stitch

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

fpdc - front post double crochet

bpdc - back post double crochet

- Written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- This beanie is made from the top down with joined rounds
- To change the pattern size, go up or down a hook size. You can also add or take out an increase round
- This baby beanie will fit approx 6 12 months. I suggest changing the hook size to make a different baby size beanie.

Approx Finished size (6-12 mo) -

Length: 6.5"

Circumference: 16"

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make a magic circle

Round 1: ch 2, 12 dc in circle, pull circle closed tight, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 2, *dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (36 dc)

Round 4: ch 2, *dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)

Round 5: ch 2, *dc in 3 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Crown diameter is approx 5.75"

Round 6 - 9: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 10 - 17: ch 2, fpdc in first stitch, bpdc in next, *fpdc in next stitch, bodc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (60) Fasten off.

Weave in the ends.
