

AUGUST SUN HAT CROCHET PATTERN



The **August Sun Hat Crochet Pattern** is the perfect summer hat! It has a tight stitch and offers full coverage from the sun. I used acrylic for this sample, but cotton would work even better!

Materials

150g worsted weight yarn (I used I Love this Yarn)

G/4.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

Level

easy

Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic circle

sl st - slip stitch

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

crab stitch (reverse single crochet) - work single crochets going in the opposite direction. Insert your hook into the stitch to the right, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through both loops on the hook.

- Written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- This beanie is made from the top down with joined, turned rounds
- To change the pattern size, go up or down a hook size. You can also add or take out an increase round

Approx Finished size (small adult) -

Length: 10"

Circumference (around base of head): 20"

AUGUST SUN HAT CROCHET PATTERN

make a magic circle

Round 1: ch 1, 6 sc in circle, pull circle closed tight, join to first sc with sl st (6 sc)

Round 2: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (12 sc)

Round 3: ch 1, turn, *sc, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (18 sc)

Round 4: ch 1, turn, *sc in 2 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (24 sc)

Round 5: ch 1, turn, *sc in 3 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (30 sc)

Round 6: ch 1, turn, *sc in 4 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (36 sc)

Round 7: ch 1, turn, *sc in 5 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (42 sc)

Round 8: ch 1, turn, *sc in 6 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (48 sc)

Round 9: ch 1, turn, *sc in 7 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (54 sc)

Round 10: ch 1, turn, *sc in 8 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (60 sc)

Round 11: ch 1, turn, *sc in 9 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (66 sc)

Round 12: ch 1, turn, *sc in 10 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (72 sc)

Round 13: ch 1, turn, *sc in 11 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (78 sc)

Round 14: ch 1, turn, *sc in 12 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (84 sc)

Crown diameter is approx 6"

Round 15 - 36: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (84 sc)

Length is approx 7"

Round 37: ch 1, turn, *sc in 5 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (98 sc)

Round 38: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (98 sc)

Round 39: ch 1, turn, *sc in 6 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (112 sc)

Round 40: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (112 sc)

Round 41: ch 1, turn, *sc in 7 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (126 sc)

Round 42: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (126 sc)

Round 43: ch 1, turn, *sc in 8 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (140 sc)

Round 44: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (140 sc)

Round 45: ch 1, turn, *sc in 9 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (154 sc)

Round 46: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (154 sc)

Round 47: ch 1, turn, *sc in 10 stitches, 2 sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (168 sc)

Round 48: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (168 sc)

Round 49: ch 1, turn, crab stitch around, join to first stitch with sl st (168)

Fasten off.

Weave in the ends.
