This **Oversized Color Block Crochet Sweater Pattern** is the comfiest & coziest around! It's cute paired with some skinny jeans or perfect for a comfy day around the house.

<u>Materials</u>

Lion Brand Color Made Easy in Alabaster (3 skeins for S/M/L, 4 skeins for L/ XL/2X/3X), Huckleberry (1 skein for S, 2 skeins for M/L/XL/2X/3X), and Horizon (1 skein for all sizes) - any bulky weight (category 5) yarn will work

L/8.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

<u>Level</u>

easy

Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

sc - single crochet

sl st - slip stitch

dc2tog - double crochet 2 together (double crochet decrease)

- written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as stitch
- This sweater is constructed with 2 rectangles sewn together. Then the yarn is joined to an armhole and the sleeves are worked in joined rounds.
- Alabaster is Color A, Horizon is Color B, Huckleberry is Color C

Pattern notes cont.

- Gauge: 8 dc x 5 rows = 4" x 4"

Sizes:

S, M, L, XL, 2X, 3X - The pattern is written in these sizes consecutively. Example, when the pattern gives the end of the row count as (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69), the 54 is for size S, 57 is M, 60 is L, 63 is XL, 65 is 2X, and 69 is 3X.

This sweater is oversized with generous positive ease.

Approx Finished Size:

Bust: S (52") M (55") L (58") XL (61") 2X (64") 3X (67")

Length: S (24") M (25.75") L (27.5") XL (29.25") 2X (31") 3X (32.75") Armhole Depth: S (7.75") M (8.5") L (9.25") XL (10") 2X (10.75") 3X (11.5")

Size Small pictured. I am 5'0" with 34" bust

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OVERSIZED COLOR BLOCK SWEATER

FRONT

With Color A ch 56, 59, 62, 65, 68, 71 (leave a long end for sewing) **Row 1**: dc in 3rd ch from the hook and across (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc) **Row 2**: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc) Repeat row 2 to **Row 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40** (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc) Fasten off.

BACK

With Color B ch 56, 59, 62, 65, 68, 71 (leave a long end for sewing) **Row 1**: dc in 3rd ch from the hook and across (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc) **Row 2**: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc) Repeat row 2 to **Row 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26** (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc) Change to Color C Repeat row 2 to **Row 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40** (54, 57, 60, 63, 65, 69 dc)

Fasten off.

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SEWING

Lay both panels with one on top of the other. Sew the shoulders closed leaving a space in the middle for the neckline (I left about an 8" space) Sew the sides closed leaving an 8", 8.75", 9.5", 10.25, 11", 11.75" space at the top for armholes. Optional: leave a 5" slit at the bottom of each side.

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.

Turn right side out

SLEEVES

Join Color A to the bottom of an armhole

Round 1: ch 1, sc evenly around the armhole (working approx 2 sc in the side of each dc), join to first sc with sl st

Round 2: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Round 3: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc2tog with sl st

Repeat Round 3 to Round 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20

Round 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Or until desired length.

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
