

## PREMIE BABY BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



This **Premie Baby Beanie Crochet Pattern** is a quick and easy pattern. Perfect for adding to your donation pile!

## Materials

25g worsted weight yarn total in 4 colors (I used WeCrochet Brava)

H/5.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

## Level

easy

## Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic circle

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

dc - double crochet

sc - single crochet

fpdc - front post double crochet

- Written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- This beanie is made from the top down in joined rounds
- the stripes at the bottom are optional. I used 3 shades of gray starting with the lightest shade working towards the dark. I changed color every round. Then ended with my original color
- To change the pattern size, go up or down a hook size. You can also add or take out an increase round.

Approx Finished size (premie) - 4" x 10"

## **PREMIE BABY BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN**

make a magic circle

**Round 1:** ch 2, 10 dc in the circle, pull circle closed, join to first dc with sl st (10 dc)

**Round 2:** ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (20 dc)

**Round 3:** ch 2, \*dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (30 dc)

*Crown diameter approx. 3.25"*

*To make the hat larger, add an additional increase round: ch 2, \*sc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, join to first dc with sl st (40)*

*Note: with the additional increase round, the ribbing won't work the exact same in the bottom rounds.*

**Round 4 - 6:** ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (30 dc)

*Begin optional striping in next round. Change color each round.*

**Round 7 - 10:** ch 1, sc in first stitch, fpdc in next, \*sc in next 2 stitches, fpdc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around, to last stitch, sc in last stitch, join to first sc with sl st (30)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
