EASY RIBBED BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



The Easy Ribbed Beanie Crochet Pattern uses a simple beanie method and is quick to work up. I love that this design uses a basic, top-down method with no sewing or difficult increases.

Materials

100g/218yds worsted weight yarn (I used WeCrochet Brava in Cobblestone Heather)

J/6.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

Level

easy+

Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic circle

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

dc - double crochet

sc - single crochet

fpdc - front post double crochet

bpdc - back post double crochet

- Written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- This beanie is made from the top down in joined rounds and joined turned rounds.
- To change the pattern size, go up or down a hook size. You can also add or take out an increase round

Approx Finished size (large adult) - 22" x 9"

EASY RIBBED BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN

make a magic circle

Round 1: ch 2, 12 dc in circle, pull circle closed tight, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 2, *dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (36 dc)

Round 4: ch 2, *dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)

Round 5: ch 2, *dc in 3 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 6: ch 2, *dc in 4 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (72 dc)

Crown diameter is approx. 7.25". To change the size, take out an increase round.

Round 7: ch 1, sc in first stitch, fpdc in next, *sc in next stitch, fpdc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (72)

Round 8: ch 1, turn, bpdc in first stitch, sc in next, *bpdc in next stitch, sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first bpdc with sl st (72)

Round 9: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, fpdc in next, *sc in next stitch, fpdc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (72)

Round 10 - 22: repeat round 8 & 9, ending with a round 8 repeat (72) Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
