Tweed Cardi

Materials

6 - 7 skeins Caron Simply Soft Tweeds in Off White

H/5.0 mm

Scissors

Yarn needle

Level

Intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

Sl st - slip stitch

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Dc - double crochet

Gauge:

6 stitch repeats = 4"

7 rows = 4"

Approximate Finished Size

S/M

L/XL

Length: 23"

Length: 27"

Width: 24"

Width: 28"

Pattern

Pattern written in S/M, L/XL noted in ()

Ch 76 (88)

Row 1: (1 sc, 1 dc) all in the 2nd ch from the hook, *skip one stitch, (1 sc, 1 dc) in the next ch* repeat from * to * across to the last 2 chs, skip one ch, sc in last (37 dc, 38 sc (43 dc, 44 sc))

Row 2: ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 dc) all in first sc, skip the next dc, *(1 sc, 1 dc) in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across, sc in last stitch (37 dc, 38 sc (43 dc, 44 sc))

Repeat row 2 to row 67 (73)

Next is the first front panel

Row 68 (74): ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 dc) all in first sc, skip next dc, *(1 sc, 1 dc) in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across 15 more times (18 more times), sc2tog over the next 2 stitches (17 dc, 17 sc, 1 sc2tog (20 dc, 20 sc, 1 sc2tog))

Row 69 (75): ch 1, turn, sc3tog, dc in same stitch, skip next dc, *(1 sc, 1 dc) all in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across, sc in last stitch (16 dc, 17 sc, 1 sc3tog (19 dc, 20 sc, 1 sc3tog))

Row 70 (76): ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 dc) all in first sc, skip the next dc, *(1 sc, 1 dc) in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across, sc in last stitch (16 dc, 17 sc (19 dc, 20 sc))

Repeat row to row 133 (139)

Fasten off



Next is the other front panel

Join yarn to row 68 (74) in the 18th (21st) dc from the left

Row 68 (74): ch 1, sc2tog over the first 2 stitches, *(1 sc, 1 dc) in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across, sc in last stitch (17 dc, 18 sc, 1 sc2tog (20 dc, 21 sc, 1 sc2tog)



Row 69 (75): ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 dc) in first sc, skip dc, *(1 sc, 1 dc) in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across 14 more times, (17 more times), sc3tog (16 dc, 16 sc, 1 sc3tog (19 dc, 19 sc, 1 sc3tog)

Row 70 (76): ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 dc) all in first sc, skip the next dc, *(1 sc, 1 dc) in next sc, skip next dc* repeat from * to * across, sc in last stitch (16 dc, 17 sc (19 dc, 20 sc)

Repeat row to row 133 (139)

Fasten off



Fold the top panels down. Sew the sides closed, leaving space at the top for armholes



Repeat on other side. Fasten off, weave in all your ends. Turn cardi right-side out so the seams are on the inside. Join yarn to bottom corner.

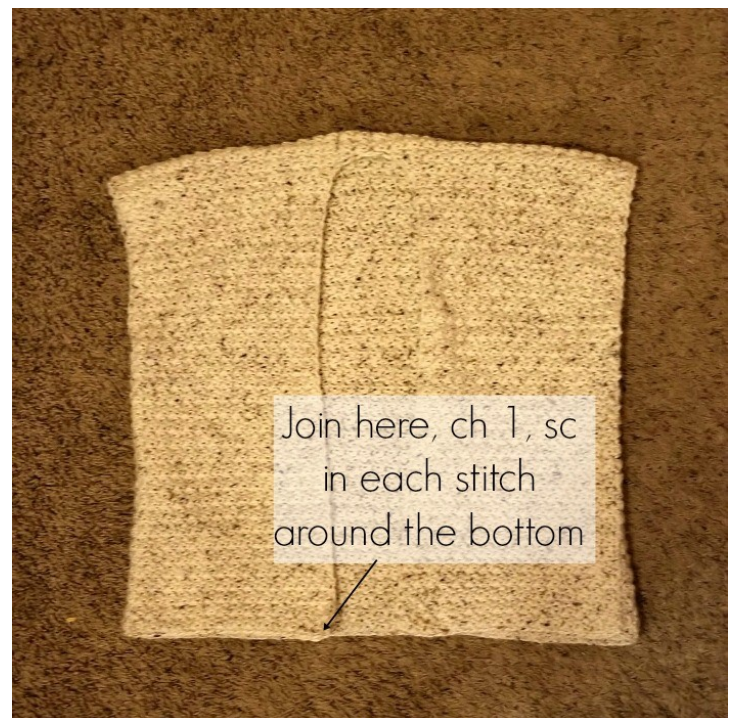
Next you'll work around the bottom

NOTE: I did not add end of row stitch numbers from here on because they can be different for everyone at this point

Row 1: ch 1, sc in each stitch around the bottom to the opposite corner

Row 2 - 10: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around

Do not fasten off



Next you'll work the collar

Row 1: ch 1, turn so you're working around the collar, sc evenly around to opposite corner

Row 2 - 5: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around

Row 6 - 10: ch 1, turn, sc in 20 stitches, hdc in next 20 stitch, dc in each stitch to last 40 stitches, hdc in next 20 stitches, sc in last 20 stitches

(I used a stitch marker to keep track of last 20 stitches in each row)

Row 11: ch 1, turn, hdc in 40 stitches, dc in each stitch to last 40 stitches, hdc in last 40 stitches

Fasten off, weave in all your ends

Sleeves

Join yarn to the bottom of a sleeve

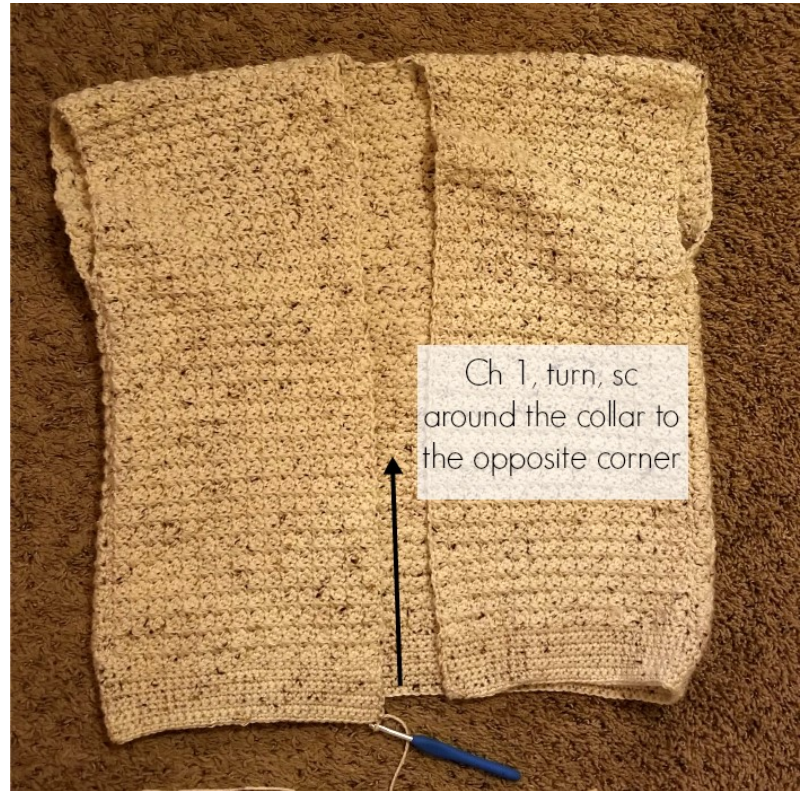
Row 1: ch 1, sc evenly around, join to first sc with sl st

Row 2 - 5: ch 1, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st

NOTE: The sleeves can be made in any length, adjust to your liking

Repeat on other sleeve

Fasten off, weave in your ends
