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Materials

1,024 - 1,280 yards worsted weight (4) yarn - I used Red Heart Soft in Seafoam and Gray Heather (2 skeins in each for S, 3 skeins Seafoam and 2 skeins Gray for M & L)

5.5 mm hook

Yarn needle

Level

Easy - you must be familiar with basic crochet stitches and techniques

Pattern notes & stitches to know

Sl st - slip stitch

Ch - chain

Dc - double crochet

NOTE: Ch 3 at the beginning of each row counts as a double crochet

Finished Size

Small

Width: 28 inches

Length: 17 inches (without fringe)

Medium - noted in ()

Width: 33 inches

Length: 19 inches

Large - noted in []

Width: 38 inches

Length: 21 inches

PONCHO (make 2)

Start with gray.

Ch 102 (112) [122]

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in 4th chain from the hook and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 5: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

NOTE: From here on, the pattern repeats rows 1 –5

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in each ch and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Switch to Seafoam

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, dc across across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 8: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 9: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 10: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 11: Ch 3, turn, dc in each ch and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 12: Ch 3, turn, dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 13: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to

Row 14: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 15: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 16: Ch 3, turn, dc in each ch and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 17: Ch 3, turn, dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 18: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 19: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 20: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 21: Ch 3, turn, dc in each ch and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 22: Ch 3, turn, dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

For small, fasten off and weave in the ends.

Continue pattern for medium—

Row 23: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 24: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 25: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 26: Ch 3, turn, dc in each ch and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 27: Ch 3, turn, dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

For medium, fasten off and weave in the ends.

Continue pattern for Large—

Row 28: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 29: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 30: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), turn, *skip ch space, dc in next stitch, ch 1* repeat from * to * across (52 dc, (57 dc), [62 dc])

Row 31: Ch 3, turn, dc in each ch and dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Row 32: Ch 3, turn, dc across (103 dc, (113 dc), [123 dc])

Fasten off, weave in the ends.

CONSTRUCTION

Fold each panel in half and lay side by side with the gray stripes on opposite ends and the fold at the top. Sew the panels together in the center with single crochet, leaving a space at the top for the neckline. Do this for the front and back. Fasten off, weave in all your ends.



Now sew the sides together using single crochet. Do this for both sides, leaving spaces for the arm holes

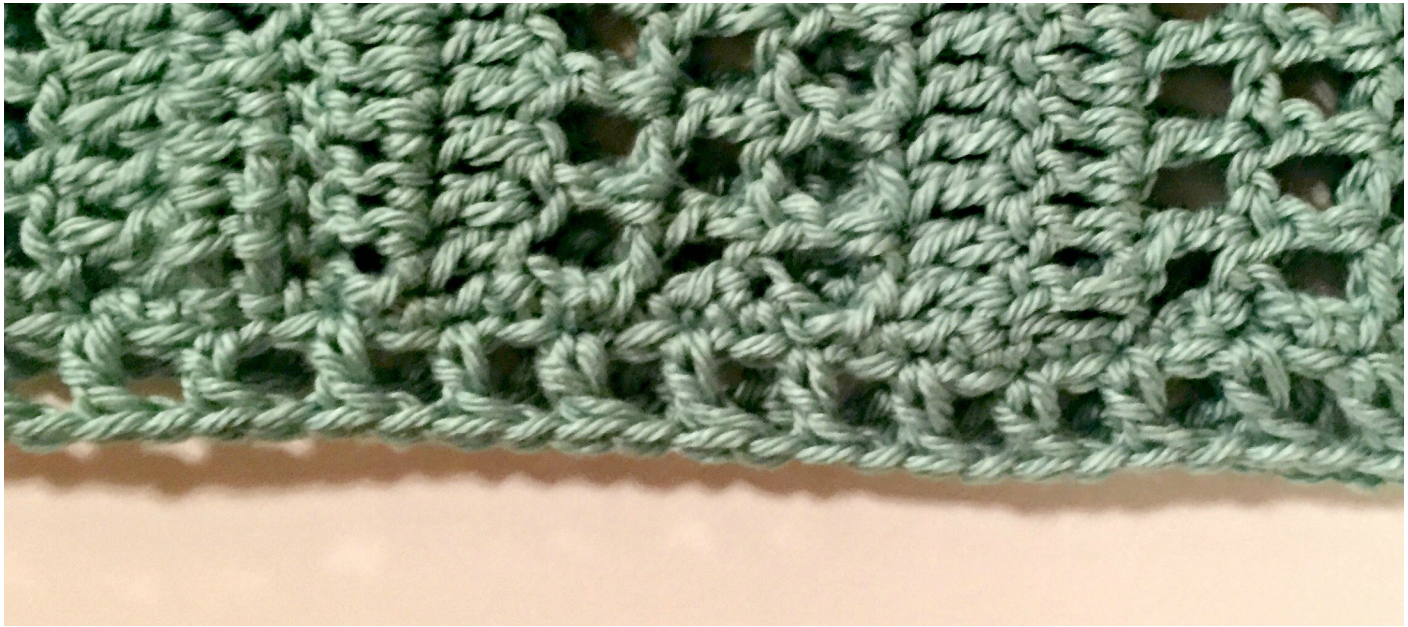


Turn poncho right-side out, with the single crochet seams on the inside.

Insert your hook into a bottom corner and single crochet around the bottom evenly.

Ch 4 (counts as dc + 1 ch), *skip one stitch, dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * around, join, fasten off and weave in the ends.

NOTE: If the last row doesn't work out perfectly, that's fine. I had an extra stitch in mine



This is along the bottom. Now add fringe to every other ch 1 space (or every space... or however you'd like :))

I added 6 pieces of 12 inch yarn (3 in gray and 3 in seafoam) to every other chain 1 space.

Then trim the fringe to your liking.

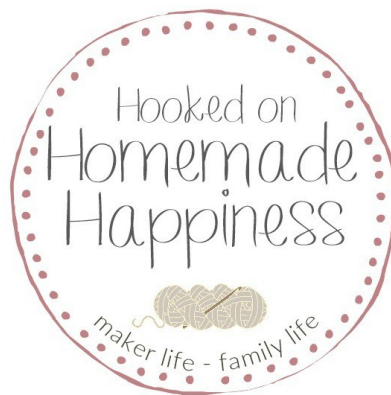
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
