**Ruffle Top Crochet
Pattern**

Materials

Caron Simply Soft in Taupe (2 skeins for S, 3 skeins for M/L, 4 skeins for XL)

5.0 mm hook

Yarn needle

scissors

Level

Intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

Sl st - slip stitch

Ch - chain

Dc - double crochet

Dc2tog - double crochet 2 together (yarn over, insert hook into stitch, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, insert hook into next stitch, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through all loops on hook)

Sc - single crochet

Approximate finished sizes:

Length: S (17") M (19") L (21") XL (23")

Width: S (16") M (18") L (20") XL (22")

Sleeves: S (10") M (12") L (14") XL (16")

Gauge:

11 dc = 4"

7 rows = 4"

Pattern

FRONT PANEL - pattern is written in S, M noted in (), L noted in [], XL noted in { }

Ch 52 (58) [64] {70}

Row 1: dc in 3rd ch and in each ch across (50 dc (56 dc) [62 dc] {68 dc})

Row 2 - 18 (19) [20] {21}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (50 dc (56 dc) [62 dc] {68 dc})

In the next rows you will start one side of the neckline

Row 19 (20) [21] {22}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in next 21 stitches, dc2tog (23 dc (26 dc) [29 dc] {32 dc})

Row 20 (21) [22] {23}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (21 dc (24 dc) [27 dc] {30 dc})

Row 21 (22) [23] {24}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (19 dc (22 dc) [25 dc] {28 dc})

Row 22 (23) [24] {25}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (17 dc (20 dc) [23 dc] {26 dc})

Row 23 (24) [25] {26}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch across (16 dc (19 dc) [22 dc] {25 dc})

Row 24 (25) [26] {27}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across to the last 2, dc2tog (15 dc (18 dc) [21 dc] {24 dc})

Row 25 (26) [27] {28}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (15 dc (18 dc) [21 dc] {24 dc})

Repeat previous row to row 30 (33) [36] {39}

Fasten off, weave in the ends.

Now you will work the other side of the neckline. Join in row 19, in the stitch next to the right neckline



Row 19 (20) [21] {22}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in next 21 stitches, dc2tog (23 dc (26 dc) [29 dc] {32 dc})

Row 20 (21) [22] {23}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (21 dc (24 dc) [27 dc] {30 dc})

Row 21 (22) [23] {24}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (19 dc (22 dc) [25 dc] {28 dc})

Row 22 (23) [24] {25}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (17 dc (20 dc) [23 dc] {26 dc})

Row 23 (24) [25] {26}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across to the last 2, dc2tog (16 dc (19 dc) [22 dc] {25 dc})

Row 24 (25) [26] {27}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch across (15 dc (18 dc) [21 dc] {24 dc})

Row 25 (26) [27] {28}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (15 dc (18 dc) [21 dc] {24 dc})

Repeat previous row to row 30 (33) [36] {39}

Do not fasten off

Ch 1, sc evenly on the inside of the neckline.

In the V of the center, slst2tog (insert hook, pull up a loop, insert hook into next stitch, pull loop through all loops on hook), then sc evenly to the other side

Fasten off, weave in the ends



BACK PANEL

Ch 52 (58) [64] {70}

Row 1: dc in 3rd ch and in each ch across (50 dc (56 dc) [62 dc] {68 dc})

Row 2 - 18 (19) [20] {21}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (50 dc (56 dc) [62 dc] {68 dc})

Row 19 (20) [21] {22}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (48 dc, (54 dc), [60 dc], {66 dc})

Row 20 (21) [22] {23}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (46 dc, (52 dc), [58 dc], {64 dc})

Row 21 (22) [23] {24}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (44 dc, (50 dc), [56 dc], {62 dc})

Row 22 (23) [24] {25}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (42 dc, (48 dc), [54 dc], {60 dc})

Row 23 (24) [25] {26}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (40 dc, (46 dc), [52 dc], {58 dc})

Row 24 (25) [26] {27}: ch 2, turn, dc2tog, dc in each stitch to the last 2, dc2tog (38 dc, (44 dc), [50 dc], {56 dc})

Row 25 (26) [27] {28}: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (38 dc, (44 dc), [50 dc], {56 dc})

Repeat previous row to row 30 (33) [36] {39}

Fasten off, weave in the ends.

CONSTRUCTION

Lay both panels on top of each other. Sew the shoulders closed with a whip stitch. Then sew down each side with a whip stitch. Starting where the armhole begins down to the bottom. Fasten off, weave in the ends.



SLEEVES

Join yarn at the bottom of one armhole

Round 1: Ch 2, sc evenly around the armhole, join to first dc with sl st


NOTE: In the next round the sleeve decreases, if you don't want the decrease, just dc in each stitch around

Round 2: ch 2, dc in same stitch, *dc2tog, dc in next stitch* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st

Round 3: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Repeat round 3 to row 8 (9) [10] {11}

In the next round you will crochet into the 3rd loop of the dc. Instead of inserting hook into the top loops, insert hook into the loop behind the top loops and work a dc



Row 9 (10) [11] {12}: ch 2, 2 dc in the 3rd loop in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Row 10 (11) [12] {13}: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Row 11 (12) [13] {14}: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Row 12 (13) [14] {15}: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st

Repeat previous row to row 15 (18) [21] {24}

Fasten off, weave in the ends.

Repeat for other sleeve.
