tern is a lightweight shawl that's perfect for cool evenings. It has a beautiful drape that lays perfectly over the shoulders. Because of the curved shape it stays on the shoulders without a shawl pin or tying.

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Materials

3 skeins Lion Brand Beautiful You (sport weight category 2 yarn)

G/4.0 mm

yarn needle

scissors

Level

Intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

sl st - slip stitch

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

bobble - *yarn over, insert into stitch, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops* repeat from * to * 2 more times, yarn over, pull through all loops on hook

- written in US terms
- ch 3 counts as dc
- ch 1 does not count as sc

Approx. Finished Size:

Length down the middle: 18"

Width across the top: 30"

AL FRESCO SHAWL CROCHET PATTERN

Ch 4, sl st to first ch to make a loop

Row 1: ch 3, working in the loop, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc (6 dc)

Row 2: ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first stitch, dc in each stitch to ch 2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch 2 space, dc in each stitch to last stitch, 3 dc in last stitch (12 dc)

Row 3: ch 4, turn, (dc, ch 1, dc) all in first stitch, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, *dc in next stitch, ch 1, skip 1 stitch* repeat from * to * across to ch 2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in ch 2 space, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, repeat from * to * across to last stitch, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) all in last stitch (12 dc)

Row 4: ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first stitch, dc in each stitch and ch space across to ch 2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in ch 2 space, dc in each stitch and ch across to last stitch, 3 dc in last stitch (28 dc)

Repeat rows 3 & 4 to Row 8

Row 9: repeat row 2 (66 dc)

Row 10: ch 3, turn, sl st in same stitch, *ch 3, skip 1 stitch, sl st in next* repeat from * to * across to ch 2 space, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in ch 2 space, ch 3, sl st in next, repeat from * to * across to last stitch (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in last stitch

Row 11: ch 3, turn, sl st in first ch 3 space, *ch 3, sl st in next ch 3 space* repeat from * to * across to corner ch 3 space, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in corner ch 3 space, repeat from * to * across to last ch 3 space, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) all in last ch 3 space

Repeat row 11 to Row 14

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Row 15: ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first ch 3 space, 3 dc in each ch 3 space across to corner ch 3 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in corner ch 3 space, 3 dc in each ch 3 space across (134 dc)

Row 16: ch 1, turn, *sc in 4 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * across to ch 2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch 2 space, repeat from * to * across (134)

Row 17 - 20: repeat row 2

Repeat rows 3 - 20 to **Row 40** (ending with a dc row)

Row 41: repeat row 10

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
