

## BABY BEAR BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



The **Baby Bear Beanie Crochet Pattern** is a simple beanie pattern with cute little ears added. This beanie works up in no time! Perfect to add to your donation pile.

## Materials

50g worsted weight yarn (I used I Love this Yarn in Linen)

l/5.5 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

stitch marker

## Level

easy

## Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic ring

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

hdc - half double crochet

sc - single crochet

blo - back loop only

- Written in US terms
- This hat is made in rounds that are not joined.
- ch 2 does not count as hdc
- ch 1 does not count as sc

Approx Finished Size-

Circumference: 12"

Length: 4.5"

## **BABY BEAR BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN**

Make a magic ring

**Round 1:** ch 2, hdc 8 in ring, pull ring closed tight (8 hdc)

*Do not join. Continue the next round working in the first stitch of round 1. You will be working in a spiral. Put your stitch marker in the first hdc of the next round*

**Round 2:** 2 hdc in each stitch around (16 hdc)

*Do not join. Continue in the round, moving the stitch marker to the first stitch of each round.*

**Round 3:** \*hdc in 1, 2 hdc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around (24 hdc)

**Round 4:** \*hdc in 2, 2 hdc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around (32 hdc)

**Round 5:** \*hdc in 3, 2 hdc in next\* repeat from \* to \* around (40 hdc)

*Crown diameter is approx. 4". To change the size, add or take out an increase round or go up or down a hook size.*

**Round 6 - 11:** hdc in each stitch around (40 hdc)

**Round 12:** sc in each stitch around (40 sc)

**Round 13 - 14:** sc blo in each stitch around (40 sc)

Sl st to next stitch. Fasten off. Weave in the ends.

**EARS** (make 2)

Make a magic ring

**Row 1:** ch 1, sc 6 in ring, do not join, pull ring closed tight

**Row 2:** ch 1, turn, \*sc in 1, 2 sc in next\* repeat from \* to \* across (9 sc)

**Row 3:** ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch across (9 sc)

Fasten off. Leave a long end for sewing.

Place the ears between rounds 2 & 4 and using the long end, sew the ears to the top of the beanie. Weave in the ends.
