RASPBERRY BABY BLANKET CROCHET PATTERN



The **Raspberry Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern** has a classic chevron stripe pattern with some fun berry stitches mixed in! For this blanket I used 4 skeins of Caron Cake yarn. I love using self striping yarn for blankets. Takes the work out of making a color scheme and there are less ends to weave in.

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Materials

4 Caron Cakes in Rhubarb Cream H/5.0 mm hook Yarn needle Scissors

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

dc3tog - double crochet 3 together

sc - single crochet

sc3tog - single crochet 3 together

berry stitch - yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through one loop on hook, yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through all 5 loops on hook (VIDEO TUTORIAL: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rF-1WnKa9IY&t=365s)

ws - wrong side

rs - right side

- written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- ch 3 counts as dc
- To adjust the width, add or take out chains as needed. Start with a
 multiple of 28 + 18. To adjust the length, add or take out rows as
 needed. End with a row 12 repeat.
- Approx Finished size: 37" X 37"

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ch 158 (mult 28 + 18)

Row 1 (ws): dc in 4th ch from the hook, dc in next 5 chs, *dc3tog over next 3 chs (this is the valley or bottom of the chevron), dc in next 12 chs, 3 dc in next (this is the peak or top of the chevron), dc in next 12 chs* repeat from * to * across to last 9 chs, dc3tog over next 3, dc in next 5 chs, 2 dc in last

Row 2 (rs): ch 3, turn, dc in same stitch, dc in next 5 stitches, *dc3tog, dc in next 12 stitches, 3 dc in next, dc in next 12* repeat from * to * across to last 9 stitches, dc3tog, dc in next 5 stitches, 2 dc in last

Row 3 (ws): repeat row 2

Row 4 (rs): repeat row 2

Row 5 (ws): ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, alternate berry and sc stitches over the next 5 stitches, *sc3tog, alternate berry and sc stitches over the next 12 stitches, (berry, sc, berry) all in the next, alternate sc and berry stitches over the next 12 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 9 stitches, sc3tog, alternate berry and sc stitches, over the next 5 stitches, 2 sc in last

Row 6 (rs): ch 1, turn, 2 sc in same stitch, sc in next 5 stitches, *sc3tog, sc in next 12 stitches, 3 sc in next, sc in next 12* repeat from * to * across to last 9 stitches, sc3tog, sc in next 5 stitches, 2 sc in last

Row 7 (ws): repeat row 5

Row 8 (rs): repeat row 6

Row 9 - 12: repeat row 2

Row 13 - 68: repeat rows 5 - 12

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
