FLOWER PETAL PRAYER SHAWL CROCHET PATTERN



The Flower Petal Prayer Shawl Crochet Pattern is a beautiful and comforting triangle shawl designed to wrap someone in warmth and love. This pattern pairs perfectly with the Flower Petal Cap and is part of the Crochet Along for a Cause—a summer-long event focused on crafting handmade items for those in need. Whether you're making it as a gift of encouragement or donating to a cancer center or shelter, this shawl offers both style and heartfelt comfort.

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<u>Materials</u>

300g worsted weight yarn (I used I Love This Yarn in Soft Pink) I/5.5 mm yarn needle scissors

<u>Level</u>

easy+

Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

hdc - half double crochet

TL - third loop (insert hook into the bar across the back of the hdc, and work stitch)

sc - single crochet

- written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- ch 2 counts as hdc
- ch 3 counts as dc
- ch 4 counts as dc + ch 1

Approx finished size: 35" x 35" 46"

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ch 4, sl st to first ch to make a loop

Row 1: ch 3, 3 dc, ch 2, 4 dc in loop (8 dc)

Row 2: ch 3, turn, dc in same stitch, dc in each stitch across to ch-2 space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space, dc in each stitch to the last stitch, 2 dc in last stitch (14 dc)

Row 3: ch 3, turn, 2 dc in same stitch, dc in each stitch across to ch-2 space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 space, dc in each stitch to the last stitch, 3 dc in last stitch (22 dc)

Row 4 - Row 24: repeat rows 2 & 3, ending with a row 2 repeat (168 dc)

Row 25: ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in first stitch, hdc in each stitch across to ch-2 space, (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in ch-2 space, hdc in each stitch to last stitch, 3 hdc in last stitch (176 hdc)

Row 26: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, sc TL in each stitch across to ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc TL in each stitch across to last stitch, 2 sc in last stitch (180 sc)

Row 27: ch 4, turn, dc in same stitch, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, *dc in next, ch 1, skip 1 stitch* repeat from * to * across to ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, *dc in next, ch 1, skip 1 stitch* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last stitch (94 dc)

Row 28: ch 4, turn, *dc in next dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across to ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, *ch 1, dc in next dc* repeat from * to * across (96 dc)

Row 29: ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in first stitch, hdc in each ch-1 space and stitch across to ch-2 space, (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in ch-2 space, hdc in each stitch to last stitch, 3 hdc in last (198 hdc)

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Row 30: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, sc TL in each stitch across to ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc TL in each stitch across to last stitch, 2 sc in last stitch (202 sc)

Round 31: ch 4, turn, dc in same stitch, *ch 1, skip 1 stitch, dc in next*, repeat from * to * across to ch-2 space, ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, ch 1, *dc in next, ch 1, skip 1 stitch* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last stitch (106 dc)

Round 32: ch 4, turn, *dc in next dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * across to ch-2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 space, *ch 1, dc in next dc* repeat from * to * across (108 dc)

Round 33: ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in first stitch, hdc in each ch-1 space and stitch across to ch-2 space, (2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in ch-2 space, hdc in each stitch to last stitch, 3 hdc in last (222 hdc)

Round 34: ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first stitch, sc TL in each stitch across to ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc TL in each stitch across to last stitch, 2 sc in last stitch (226 sc)

Round 35: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, skip 1 stitch, 5 hdc in next, skip 1, *sc in next, skip 1, 5 hdc in next, skip 1* repeat from * to * across to last stitch before ch-2, sc in last stitch, 7 hdc in ch-2 space, sc in next, *skip 1, 5 hdc in next, skip 1, sc in next* repeat from * to * across

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
