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WAFFLE BRIM BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



Welcome to Week 3 of the *Crochet Along for a Cause*! This week's featured pattern is the **Waffle Brim Beanie Crochet Pattern**—a stylish and cozy hat that combines basic crochet techniques with beautiful texture. Whether you're stitching for men, women, or charity, this beanie is quick to make and full of personality!

Materials

worsted weight yarn
H/5.0 mm hook
yarn needle
scissors

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

magic loop
ch - chain
sl st - slip stitch
dc - double crochet
fpdc - front post double crochet
rs - right side
ws - wrong side

- written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- This beanie is worked from top down in joined rounds starting with a magic loop. The waffle stitch section is made in turned rounds.
- The pattern is written in 2 adult sizes (Sm & Lg). The pattern is written in these sizes consecutively. Example, when the pattern gives the end of row count ((60, 72) dc) the 60 is for Sm and the 72 is Lg. To make a beanie size in between, make the small with a J hook.

Approx Finished Size:

Circumference: (20", 22")

Length: (8", 8.5")

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Make a magic loop

Round 1: ch 2, dc 12 into loop, pull loop closed tight, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 2, *dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (36 dc)

Round 4: ch 2, *dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)


Round 5: ch 2, *dc in 3 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 6: ch 2, *dc in 4 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (72 dc)

Small Adult size stop increasing here: crown diameter is approx 6.5"
Skip to arrow.

Round 7: ch 2, *dc in 5 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (84 dc)

Large Adult size stop increasing here: crown diameter is approx 7.5"
Skip to arrow.

 **Next round for all sizes:** ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st ((72, 84) dc)

Round (8, 9) (rs): ch 2, *fpdc in 1 stitch, dc in next 2* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((72, 84) dc)

Round (9, 10) (ws): ch 2, turn, *fpdc in 2 stitches, dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((72, 84) dc)

Round (10, 11) (rs): ch 2, turn, *fpdc in 1 stitch, dc in next 2* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((72, 84) dc)

Repeat previous 2 rounds to **Round (21, 23)** ((72, 84) dc)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
