BASKETWEAVE BORDER SCARF CROCHET PATTERN



To go along with this week's Basketweave Brim Beanie, we're also releasing the **Basketweave Border Scarf Crochet Pattern**—the perfect companion piece to make a warm, coordinated winter set.

This scarf is worked as a solid rectangle in simple stitches for warmth and comfort, with the basketweave stitch worked around the border for a textured, polished finish.

Materials

400g worsted weight acrylic yarn
H/5.0 mm hook
yarn needle
scissors

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch - chain
sc - single crochet
hdc - half double crochet
dc - double crochet
fpdc - front post double crochet
bpdc - back post double crochet

- written in US terms
- ch 2 counts as hdc
- This scarf is a rectangle made in rows. The basketweave stitch is worked into the rows.
- This is a wide scarf. To change the width, take out chains. The starting chain needs to be a multiple of 6 + 4

Approximate Finished Size:

55" x 13"

BASKETWEAVE BORDER SCARF CROCHET PATTERN

ch 46 (mult of 6 + 4)

Row 1: starting in 3rd ch from the hook, dc in each ch across (44 dc)

Row 2: ch 2, turn, *fpdc in 3 stitches, bpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, hdc in last stitch (42 dc, 2 hdc)

Row 3: ch 2, turn, *fpdc in 3 stitches, bpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, hdc in last stitch (42 dc, 2 hdc)

Row 4: ch 2, turn, *fpdc in 3 stitches, bpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, hdc in last stitch (42 dc, 2 hdc)

Row 5 - 7: ch 2, turn, bpdc in 3 stitches, hdc in each stitch across to last 4 stitches, fpdc in 3 stitches, hdc in last (38 hdc, 6 dc)

Row 8 - 10: ch 2, turn, fpdc in 3 stitches, hdc in each stitch across to last 4 stitches, bpdc in 3 stitches, hdc in last (38 hdc, 6 dc)

Row 11 - 124: repeat rows 5 - 10

To adjust the length, add or take out rows. End with a row 10 repeat.

Row 125: ch 2, turn, *bpdc in 3 stitches, fpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, hdc in last stitch (42 dc, 2 hdc)

Row 126: ch 2, turn, *bpdc in 3 stitches, fpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, hdc in last stitch (42 dc, 2 hdc)

Row 127: ch 2, turn, *bpdc in 3 stitches, fpdc in 3 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last stitch, hdc in last stitch (42 dc, 2 hdc)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
