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BOBBLE BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



Welcome to Week 7 of the Crochet Along for a Cause! This week, we're adding a fun and textured project to our collection – the **Bobble Beanie Crochet Pattern**. This cozy hat is worked from the top down in turned rounds and features the playful bobble stitch for lots of texture and warmth.

Like many of our patterns this year, the Bobble Beanie also has a matching scarf so you can donate a beautiful set. Handmade sets like these are especially appreciated in shelters, since they bring both comfort and a little extra cheer.

Materials

worsted weight yarn
H/5.0 mm hook
yarn needle
scissors

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

- magic loop
sl st - slip stitch
ch - chain
foundation dc
dc - double crochet
sc - single crochet
bobble - *yarn over, insert into stitch, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops* repeat 4 more times. You have 6 loops on hook. Yarn over, pull through all loops on hook
fpdc - front post double crochet
bpdc - back post double crochet
- written in US terms
 - ch 2 does not count as dc
 - This beanie is worked from top down in turned, joined rounds starting with a magic loop.
 - This beanie is a small adult. To make it larger, use a J/6.0 mm hook

Approx. Finished Size:

Length: 8"

Circumference: 18"

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Make a magic loop

Round 1: ch 2, dc 12 into loop, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch around, join to first sc with sl st (12 sc)

Round 3: ch 2, turn, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (24 dc)

Round 4: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, bobble in next, *sc in next 5 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * around to last 4, sc in last 4, join to first sc with sl st (4 bobbles, 20 sc)

Round 5: ch 2, turn, *dc in 1, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (36 dc)

Round 6: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, bobble in next, *sc in next 5 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * around to last 4, sc in last 4, join to first sc with sl st (6 bobbles, 30 sc)

Round 7: ch 2, turn, *dc in 2, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)

Round 8: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, bobble in next, *sc in next 5 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * around to last 4, sc in last 4, join to first sc with sl st (8 bobbles, 40 sc)

Round 9: ch 2, turn, *dc in 3, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Crown diameter is approx 6.5"

Round 10: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, bobble in next, *sc in next 5 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * around to last 4, sc in last 4, join to first sc with sl st (10 bobbles, 50 sc)

Round 11: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 12: ch 1, turn, sc in 4 stitches, bobble in next, *sc in 5 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * around to last stitch, sc in last, join to first sc with sl st (10 bobbles, 50 sc)

Round 13: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 14: ch 1, turn, sc in first stitch, bobble in next, *sc in next 5 stitches, bobble in next* repeat from * to * around to last 4, sc in last 4, join to first sc with sl st (10 bobbles, 50 sc)

Round 15 - 18: repeat rounds 11 - 14

Round 19: ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (60 dc)

Round 20: ch 1 turn, sc in first stitch, bpdc in next, *sc in next, bpdc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (30 sc, 30 dc)

Round 21: ch 1, turn, fpdc in first stitch, sc in next, *fpdc in next, sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st (30 sc, 30 dc)

Round 22: ch 1 turn, sc in first stitch, bpdc in next, *sc in next, bpdc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (30 sc, 30 dc)

Round 23: ch 1, turn, fpdc in first stitch, sc in next, *fpdc in next, sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st (30 sc, 30 dc)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
