RIBBED BABY BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



It's Week 8 of the Crochet Along for a Cause, and this week we're making the **Ribbed Baby Beanie Crochet Pattern!** This cozy little hat is worked from the top down, starting with a simple double crochet crown. Once the crown is complete, the bottom section is finished in a classic ribbing pattern using front post and back post double crochet stitches. The result is a stretchy, snug, and warm beanie—perfect for keeping little heads toasty!

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Materials

worsted weight yarn H/5.0 mm hook yarn needle scissors

Level

easy

Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic loop
sl st - slip stitch
ch - chain
dc - double crochet
fpdc - front post double crochet
bpdc - back post double crochet

- Written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- This beanie is made from the top down with joined rounds
- This baby beanie will fit approx 3-6 months. To make a newborn, go down a hook size (G/4.0 mm). To make 6-12 months, go up a hook size (J/6.0 mm)

Approx Finished size (3-6 mo) -

Length: 5"

Circumference: 13"

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make a magic loop

Round 1: ch 2, 12 dc in circle, pull circle closed tight, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 2, *dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (36 dc)

Round 4: ch 2, *dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)

Crown diameter is approx 4.75"

Round 5-6: ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join to first dc with sl st (48 dc)

Round 7-11: ch 2, fpdc in first stitch, bpdc in next, *fpdc in next stitch, bpdc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (48) Fasten off.

Weave in the ends.
