SWEET SCALLOPS BABY BLANKET CROCHET PATTERN



This week, we're pairing the Sweet Scallops Baby Beanie with a coordinating Sweet Scallops Baby Blanket Crochet Pattern—a soft, textured design that's just as charming and delicate as the hat. Whether you're making a full set to donate or just looking for a beautiful baby blanket pattern, this one's sure to be a favorite!

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Materials

260g worsted weight acrylic yarn I/5.5 mm hook yarn needle scissors
4 stitch markers (optional)

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & stitches to know

sl st - slip stich

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

CL- cluster - (*yarn over, insert hook into stitch, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops* repeat from * to * once more, yarn over and pull through remaining loops on hook)

CL V st - (CL, ch 2, CL) all in same stitch

hdc - half double crochet

sc - single crochet

TL– third loop only - insert hook in the horizontal bar on the back of hdc and work stitch

- Written in US terms
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- This blanket Is made from the center out in joined rounds.
- This is a small baby blanket. To make is larger, add rounds until desired size.

Approximate Finished Size (Baby): 24" x 24"

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Ch 4, join to first ch with sl st to make a loop

Round 1: ch 2, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2) all in loop, join to first dc with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: sl st to ch-2 space, ch 2, (CL V st, ch 2, CL V st) in each ch-2 space around, join to first CL with sl st (8 CL V st)

The ch-2 spaces between the CL are the corners.

Optional: place a stitch marker in each of the corner ch-2 spaces

Round 3: sl st to corner ch-2 space, ch 2, CL Vst in each ch-2 space around, join to first CL with sl st (12 CL V st)

Round 4: sl st to corner ch-2 space, *(CL V st, ch 2, CL V st) in corner ch-2 space, CL V st in each ch-2 space across to corner* repeat from * to * around, join to first CL with sl st (16 V st)

Round 5 - 16: repeat rounds 3 & 4 (ending with a round 4 repeat) (64 CL V st)

Round 17: sl st to corner ch-2 space, *(2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in corner ch-2 space, hdc in each CL and 2 hdc in each ch-2 space across to corner* repeat from * to * around, join to first hdc with sl st (272 hdc)

Round 18: sl st to ch-2 space, *(2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in ch-2 space, hdc TL in each stitch across to corner* repeat from * to * around, join to first hdc with sl st (288 hdc)

Round 19: sl st to ch-2 space, *(2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc) in ch-2 space, hdc TL in each stitch across to corner* repeat from * to * around, join to first hdc with sl st (304 hdc)

Round 20: sl st to ch-2 space, *(sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, sc TL in each stitch across to corner* repeat from * to * around, join to first sc with sl st (312 sc)

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Round 21: sl st to ch-2 space, ch 2 *(7 dc in ch-2 space), skip 1, 5 dc in next, [skip 2, sc in next, skip 2, 5 dc in next] repeat from [to] across to last stitch, sc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st

Fasten off.

Weave in the ends.
