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2026 STITCH SAMPLER SCRAPGHAN PART 3 - EXTREME DROP LEAF STITCH



Materials

worsted weight acrylic yarn in 2 or 3 colors (I used Hobby Lobby I Love This Yarn)

H/5.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

Level

easy

Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet

DL - drop leaf stitch (yarn over, insert hook into next ch space, pull up a loop, repeat again in same ch space, yarn over, insert hook into ch space in the row below, pull up a loop, repeat again in same ch space, yarn over, insert hook into ch space in 2 rows below, repeat again in same ch space, yarn over, insert hook into ch space in the row below, repeat again in same ch space, yarn over, insert hook into next ch space, repeat again in same ch space, yarn over, pull through all 21 loops)

rs - right side

ws - wrong side

- written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- This stitch requires a starting chain of 12 + 3

Scrapghan Tips

- This blanket will use different hook sizes depending on the stitch. Some stitches work up tighter than others. Even with changing hook sizes, the blanket will not have completely straight edges.
- Feel free to adjust your hook size according to how you crochet.
- This blanket requires a foundation row that is a multiple of $24 + 2$.
- The starting chain requirement for this particular stitch is given in the pattern notes (this may or may not match what was used for the entire blanket). This is just a note given for use of this stitch in other projects, not for this blanket.
- Each part starts over at row 1 of that stitch. Be sure to place a stitch marker and the last stitch of each part to mark where the next part begins.

PART 3 - EXTREME DROP LEAF STITCH

Row 1 (rs): ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (146 dc)

Row 2 (ws): ch 2, turn, dc in 7 stitches, *ch 1, dc in 12 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 7 stitches, ch 1, dc in remaining stitches (146 dc)

Row 3 (rs): ch 2, turn, dc in 6 stitches, *ch 1, dc in next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 space), ch 1, dc in next 10 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 8 stitches, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 space), ch 1, dc in remaining stitches (146 dc)

Row 4 (ws): ch 2, turn, dc in 5 stitches, *ch 1, dc in next 4 dc (skipping the ch-1 spaces), ch 1, dc in next 8 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 9, dc in next 4 dc (skipping the ch-1 spaces), ch 1, dc in remaining stitches (146 dc)

Change to Leaf Color

Row 5 (rs): ch 1, turn, sc in 5 stitches, *DL stitch, ch 3, sc in 8 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last ch-1 space, DL stitch, ch 3, sc in remaining stitches (98 sc, 12 DL)

Row 6 (ws): ch 1, turn, *sc in each sc to ch space, 2 sc in ch space, sc in hole on top of leaf, sc in top loops of leaf* repeat from * to * across to last 5 stitches, sc in last 5 (146 sc)

Change color

Row 7 (rs): ch 2, turn, dc in each stitch across (146 dc)

Row 8 (ws): ch 2, turn, dc in 13 stitches, ch 1, dc in 12 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 13 stitches, ch 1, dc in remaining stitches (146 dc)

Row 9 (rs): ch 2, turn, dc in 12 stitches, *ch 1, dc in next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 space), ch 1, dc in next 10 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 14 stitches, ch 1, dc in next 2 dc (skipping the ch-1 space), ch 1, dc in remaining stitches (146 dc)

Row 10 (ws): ch 2, turn, dc in 11 stitches, *ch 1, dc in next 4 dc (skipping the ch-1 spaces), ch 1, dc in next 8 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last 15, dc in next 4 dc (skipping the ch-1 spaces), ch 1, dc in remaining stitches (146 dc)

Change to Leaf Color

Row 11 (rs): ch 1, turn, sc in 11 stitches, *DL stitch, ch 3, sc in 8 stitches* repeat from * to * across to last ch-1 space, DL stitch, ch 3, sc in remaining stitches (102 sc, 11 DL)

Row 12 (ws): ch 1, turn, *sc in each sc to ch space, 2 sc in ch space, sc in hole on top of leaf, sc in top loops of leaf* repeat from * to * across to last 5 stitches, sc in last 5 (146 sc)

Fasten off.

To make this section longer, start back at row 1.

Place a stitch marker in the last row of this section.
