## EASY ALL HDC BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



## Materials

worsted weight yarn in 2 colors (I used I Love this Yarn)

J/6.0, I/5.5, H/5.0 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

stitch marker

## Level

easy

## Pattern notes & stitches to know

ch - chain

hdc - half double crochet

rep - repeat

sc - single crochet

sl st - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)

\* \* - work step in between asterisks

### **Special Stitches:**

TL - third loop (insert hook into horizontal bar in the back of hdc and work stitch)

Magic Loop - an adjustable loop for projects made in the round

## Pattern Notes cont

- written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as hdc
- Beanie is made from the top down in continuous rounds. Meaning there is no join, but made in a spiral. A stitch marker is required for keeping track of first stitch
- Pattern is written in 3 main parts: Crown, Body, and Textured Brim
- Pattern is written in 6 sizes consecutively: (baby, toddler, child) (Teen, Med Adult, Lg Adult)
- Sizing is based on the chart below.

Hat Size by Age	Crown Diameter	Hat Length	Circumference
Preemie	3 - 3.5"	4" - 5"	11" - 12"
Newborn - 3 mo	3.5" - 4"	5" - 5.5"	12" - 13"
3 mo - 6 mo	4" - 5"	5.5" - 6"	13" - 14"
6 mo - 12 mo	5" - 5.5"	6" - 6.5"	14" - 16"
1-3 Toddler	5.5" - 6"	6.5" - 7.5"	16" - 17"
Child	6" - 6.5"	7.5" - 8"	17" - 19"
Teen/Small Adult	6.5" - 7"	8" - 8.25"	19" - 20"
Medium Adult	7" - 7.25"	8.25" - 8.5"	20" - 22"
Large Adult	7.25" - 7.5"	8.5" - 9"	22" - 23"

## CROCHET PATTERN WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS

Sizes Baby, Teen, Lg Adult use J/6.0 mm hook

Sizes Toddler, Med Adult use H/5.0 mm hook

Size Child use I/5.5 mm hook

### **CROWN**

Starting with main color, make a magic loop

**Round 1:** ch 1, hdc 10 in ring, cinch loop closed tight

*Place a stitch marker in the first hdc of the next round*

**Round 2:** 2 hdc in each st around (20 hdc)

**Round 3:** \*hdc in 1, 2 hdc in next\* rep from \* to \* around (30 hdc)

**Round 4:** \*hdc in 2, 2 hdc in next\* rep from \* to \* around (40 hdc)

**Round 5:** \*hdc in 3, 2 hdc in next\* rep from \* to \* around (50 hdc)

*Size Baby - go to BODY*

**Round 6:** \*hdc in 4, 2 hdc in next\* rep from \* to \* around (60 hdc)

*Size Child, Toddler, & Teen- go to BODY*

**Round 7:** \*hdc in 5, 2 hdc in next\* rep from \* to \* around (70 hdc)

*Size Med Adult & Lg Adult - go to BODY*

### **BODY**

**Round (6, 7, 7) (7, 8, 8) :** hdc in each st around ((50, 60, 60) (60, 70, 70) hdc)

Repeat previous round to **Round (12, 16, 16) (16, 18, 18)**

Or until desired length before textured brim

## TEXTURED BRIM

*Change to brim color*

**Round (13, 17, 17) (17, 19, 19):** hdc in each st around ((50, 60, 60) (60, 70, 70) hdc)

**Round (14, 18, 18) (18, 20, 20):** hdcTL in each st around ((50, 60, 60) (60, 70, 70) hdc)

Repeat previous round to **Round (17, 21, 21) (21, 23, 23)**

*Change to main color*

**Round (18, 22, 22) (22, 24, 24):** scTL in each st around ((50, 60, 60) (60, 70, 70) hdc)

Sl st to next st. Fasten off. Weave in the ends.
