

EVERGREEN BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN



Materials

worsted weight yarn (I used Hobby Lobby I Love This Yarn)

I/5.5 mm hook

G+/4.5 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

rep - repeat

sc - single crochet

sl st - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)

† - turn

* * - work step in between asterisks

Special Stitches:

fpdc - front post double crochet

bpdc - back post double crochet

fpdc3tog - front post double crochet 3 together

bpdc3 tog - back post double crochet 3 together

Pattern Notes cont

- written in US terms
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- ch 2 does not count as dc
- Pattern is written in 3 main parts: Ribbing, Body, and Crown
- Beanie is made from the bottom up starting with the ribbing.
- The body is made in joined rounds. Pattern is written in 6 sizes consecutively: (baby, toddler, child) (Teen, Med Adult, Lg Adult)
- Sizing is based on the chart below.

Hat Size by Age	Crown Diameter	Hat Length	Circumference
Preemie	3 - 3.5"	4" - 5"	11" - 12"
Newborn - 3 mo	3.5" - 4"	5" - 5.5"	12" - 13"
3 mo - 6 mo	4" - 5"	5.5" - 6"	13" - 14"
6 mo - 12 mo	5" - 5.5"	6" - 6.5"	14" - 16"
1-3 Toddler	5.5" - 6"	6.5" - 7.5"	16" - 17"
Child	6" - 6.5"	7.5" - 8"	17" - 19"
Teen/Small Adult	6.5" - 7"	8" - 8.25"	19" - 20"
Medium Adult	7" - 7.25"	8.25" - 8.5"	20" - 22"
Large Adult	7.25" - 7.5"	8.5" - 9"	22" - 23"

EVERGREEN BEANIE CROCHET PATTERN

Sizes Baby, Child, & Med Adult use 4.5 mm

Size Toddler, Teen, & Lg Adult use 5.5 mm

RIBBING

ch 9

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch and across (8 sc)

Row 2 - Row (56, 56, 70) (70, 84, 84): ch 1, t, sc in first st, sc blo in next 6, sc in last (8 sc)

To customize the circumference, have any even number of rows.

Bring both short ends together. Sew the short ends together with a sl st. Do not fasten off. In the next round, work along the rough edge.

BODY

Round 1: ch 1, sc in the end of each row, join to first st with sl st ((56, 56, 70)(70, 84, 84) sc)

Round 2: ch 2, dc in each st around, join to first dc with sl st ((56, 56, 70)(70, 84, 84) dc)

Round 3: ch 2, *fpdc, bpdc* rep from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((56, 56, 70)(70, 84, 84) sts)

Round 4: ch 2, *bpdc, fpdc* rep from * to * around, join to first bpdc with sl st ((56, 56, 70)(70, 84, 84) sts)

Rep round 3 & 4 to **Round (7, 9, 11) (11, 13, 13)** (or to any odd numbered round)

CROWN

Round (8, 10, 12) (12, 14, 14): ch 2, *bpdc, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc, bpdc3tpg, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc3tog* rep from * to * around, join to first bpdc with sl st ((40, 40, 50) (50, 60, 60) sts)

Round (9, 11, 13) (13, 15, 15): ch 2, *fpdc, bpdc* rep from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((40, 40, 50) (50, 60, 60) sts)

Round (10, 12, 14) (14, 16, 16): ch 2, *bpdc, fpdc, bpdc3tog, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc3tog* rep from * to * around, join to first bpdc with sl st ((24, 24, 30) (30, 36, 36) sts)

Round (11, 13, 15) (15, 17, 17): ch 2, *fpdc, bpdc* rep from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((24, 24, 30) (30, 36, 36) sts)

Round (12, 14, 16) (16, 18, 18): ch 2, *bpdc3tog, fpdc3tog* rep from * to * around, join to first bpdc with sl st ((8, 8, 10) (10, 12, 12) sts)

Round (13, 15, 17) (17, 19, 19): ch 2, *fpdc, bpdc* rep from * to * around, join to first fpdc with sl st ((8, 8, 10) (10, 12, 12) sts)

Fasten off. Leave a long end for sewing.

Weave the long end in and out of the top sts in the last round. Pull to cinch closed. Sew top closed. Weave in all the ends.
